<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Label EVERY article of clothing and all personal clothing items with a name tag. • Clearly label all belongings, eg watches, calculators, iPods, phones, etc. • Students are responsible for all personal possessions and are encouraged to lock away valuable items. • All uniform and clothing can go to the school laundry, which operates on weekdays. • The School cannot take responsibility for lost, borrowed or damaged articles of clothing or other personal possessions. • Any electrical item brought to school, ie hairdryers, powerboards, etc should be tested and tagged prior to bringing to school. • All medication, along with over-the-counter medication such as Panadol and vitamins, are to be handed into the Medical Centre on arrival at the beginning of term.
